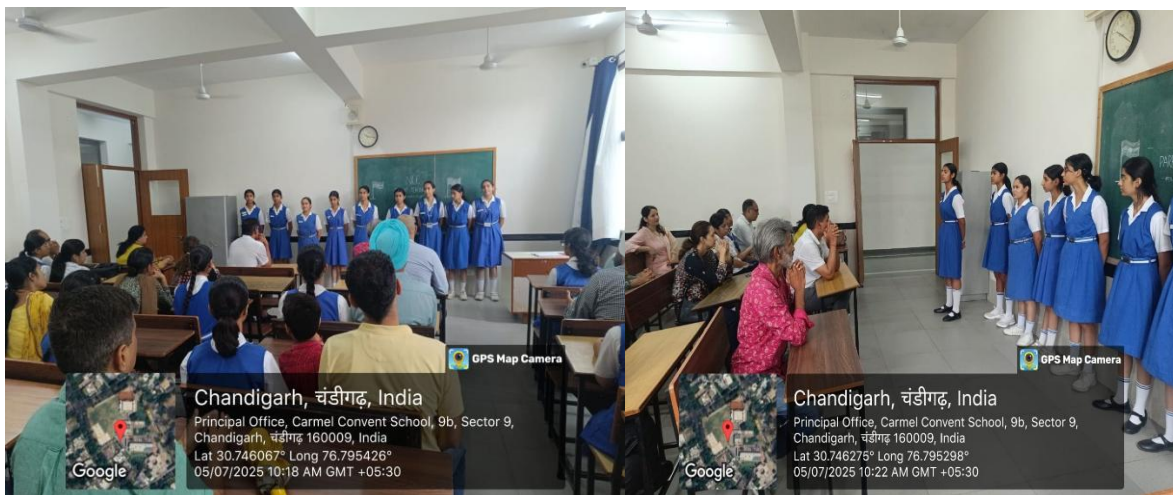

NCC CLASS TAKEN BY PI STAFF FROM NCC UNIT

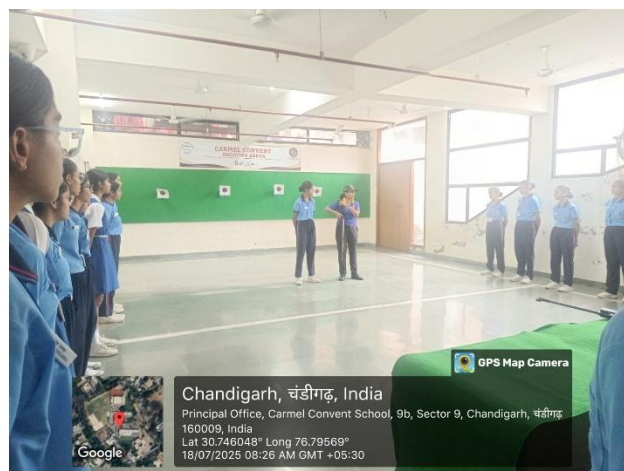
On 9th July PI Staff from NCC naval wing took the class of service subject as well brief them about the naval orientation

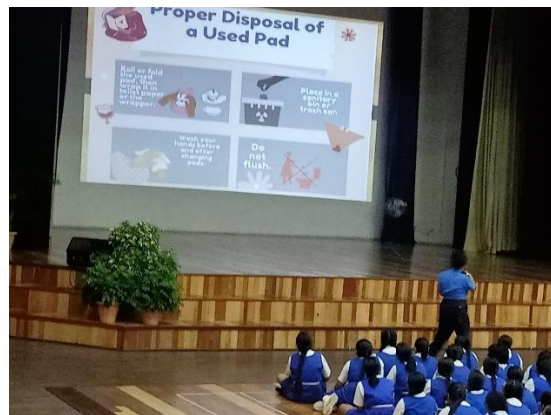


On 18th July the cadets were given exposure of firing in zero period by ANO Preeti Swami

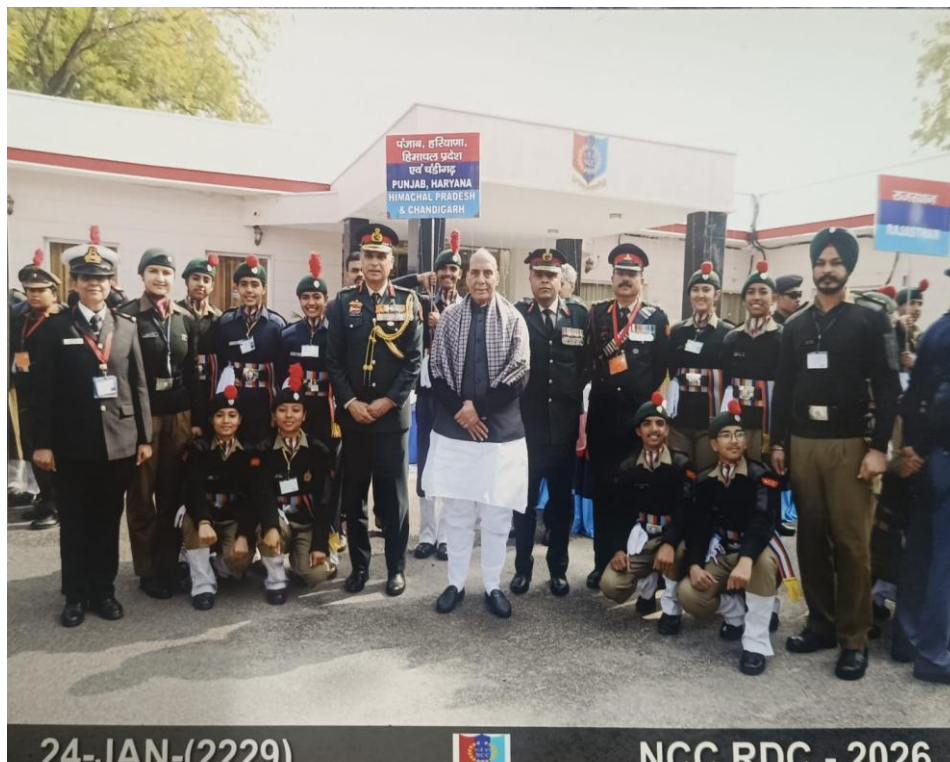
