<u>August</u>



Cdt. Aasvi Suroy won 3rd Prize on 3rd September in the weight lifting competition(open) held today in Sector 42 Sports Complex.




On 5th September Ex Cadets and Cadets of current batch presented cards and diaries to the teachers as the token of love from their side.
